LIVESTOCK CLASSES

Water will be available on site for livestock but there are NO Wash Rack Facilities

- Breed Registration papers are required for Purebred Classes – otherwise the animal is considered a Commercial.
- In order to have a Breed Division, we will require at least 7 head representing that breed entered. Any breed representing less than 7 head, will be shown in the “All Other Breeds” Division. Commercial cattle will be shown in a separate division.

- A – Red Angus
- B – Black Angus
- C – Charolais
- D – Simmental
- E – Shorthorn
- F – Limousin
- G – Gelbvieh
- H - Hereford
- I - All Other Breeds
- J - Commercial

Heifer calves shown at side with dam are eligible to enter the heifer calf classes.

- Class 1 Heifer calf, born on or after January 1st 2022
- Class 2 Yearling Heifer, born January 1st 2021 to December 31st 2021
- Class 3 Two Year Old Cow/Calf Pair, with natural 2022 calf at side (cow born between January 1st 2020 to December 31st 2020)
- Class 4 Mature Cow/Calf Pair, with natural 2022 calf at side (cow born in 2019 and prior)
- Class 5 Steers born on or after January 1st 2022



ENTRIES

Entry Deadline October 1st 2022

- Entry Fee \$75/participant
- No additional fees for livestock entries
- Showmanship Entry is included with Entry Fee
- ENTRY FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE unless the event is cancelled for any unforeseen reasons
- Every participant will receive an article of clothing. Requested clothing size may not be available for late entries.

- **Juniors, Intermediate and Senior Showmanship** will take place immediately after the conclusion of the confirmation and prospect steer show beginning with the Senior Showmanship Class.

RULES & GUIDELINES

1. Claybank Brick Plant National Historic Site is not responsible for any accident, injury or damage suffered to person's or property while at the show & grounds
2. The Claybank Bricks and Beef Show Committee, Judges & Volunteers are not responsible for any accident, injury or damage suffered to person's or property while at the show & grounds
3. Livestock must have a CCIA Tag
4. Livestock must be tied with a suitable halter & neck tie
5. Show is open to Juniors (Age 6-21 as of January 1st 2022)
6. Registration papers must be available upon request & at registration.
7. Tattoos must be legible, spot checks will be done.
8. The Show Committee is not responsible for accident or loss
9. Adult participation in the show is discouraged except in the event of a safety risk to the participant.
10. The show committee reserves the right to deny entry to the show.
11. Cattle may only be shown in one class, except for heifer calves which may be shown alongside their dam and in their respective breed heifer calf class, this is a separate entry.
12. No animals with ringworm will be allowed on the grounds
13. No farm signage
14. All rules & complaints will be left to the discretion of the show committee to make the final decision.
15. Any youth entering the showing for the Youth Show MUST be a paid & registered Bricks and Beef Show Participant.
16. No indoor stalling will be available (stall at your trailer)
17. Participants will be required to pick up after themselves (including straw, hay, trash, etc) **You are responsible for cleaning up your stalling.**
18. All participants are encouraged to bring their own generator.
19. There will be no bedding supplied.
20. Marshallers will not be responsible for locating participants at their trailer/stall area for their class. It is the participants responsibility to be on time.



CAMPING

- Non serviced camping is available on site.

PICTURES

- If you **Do Not** want pictures taken of your child, you must inform committee members. Your child will be supplied with a ribbon to wear to inform our photographers not to take their photos.
- By entering the show, and not informing the committee otherwise, you are giving us permission to use your child's photos on our social media throughout the duration, as well as following the event.
